

SaFA Book Prizes 2021

Dear colleagues,

The Executive Committee of SAfA and the Organizing Committee of the SAfA 2021 Conference invite you to submit books and monographs for the SAfA Book Prizes. Entries will be judged by Prof. Willeke Wendrich and Dr Guillaume Porraz and may be submitted in either English or French. Three categories of book prize will be awarded:

- 1 - best solo authored book or monograph
- 2 - best edited volume on a single site or small research area representing the work of an individual team of researchers
- 3 - best edited volume on any other topic.

Entries are limited to one per category per publishing press. One hard copy of the title should be submitted to each judge so that they can, after the conference, be redistributed to African institutions. However, where this may not be possible because postage is slow or unreliable, arrangements should be made directly with the judges for the submission of pdf versions instead.
